How It Works

Any business that pays Business & Occupation (B&O) or Public Utility Tax (PUT) can make a contribution to the Port Angeles Downtown Association. In return they receive a credit on their B&O tax the following year equal to 75% of the contribution.

You simply request to make a donation with the Washington State Department of Revenue. Once you are eligible (which is usually right away) you are able to make a contribution directly to the Port Angeles Downtown Association.

There is a statewide cap on the amount of credits per year, so it's first come, first served starting January 1. Register to make a contribution early, so your contribution will count and you'll receive the credit. The money needs to be paid to the Downtown Association by the end of the year.

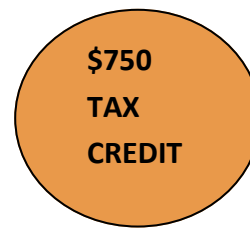

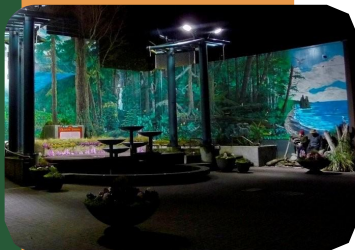
What The Funds Are Used For

Your contribution may be used for special projects, to help businesses, for day to day operations, or in any manner that assists us in our mission as we develop and

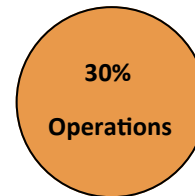
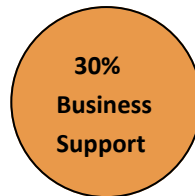
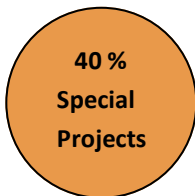
promote a healthy and prosperous downtown.
