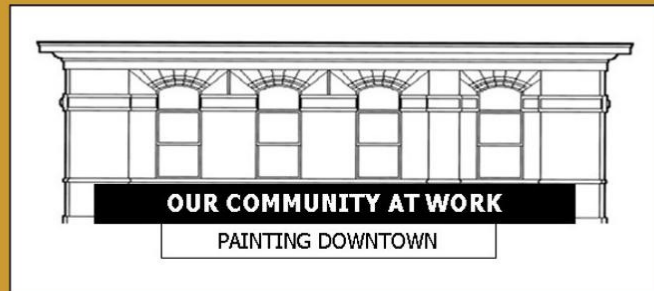

Our goal is to scrub, polish and paint downtown during the Hood Canal Bridge construction, May 1 to June 15, and present a clean, fresh, rejuvenated look to our city when the tourism season arrives.
