

PARKING COMMITTEE MEETING  
MINUTES  
JANUARY 19, 2010

Discussion of removal of \$7500.00 “buy in” fee for businesses needing additional parking spaces to meet minimum parking requirements. Nathan stated that the Planning Commission process with permitting and CEPA requirements should insure that parking needs can still be met as the result of any new development that will create the need for additional parking.

Jim M and James B reviewed the plan for roadway surfacing improvements on Front/First Street between Lincoln and Valley Streets entailing resurfacing the existing roadway, removing parking T’s, updating storm drains and adding bike lanes on the north and south sides. The parking lane will be 8’ feet wide and recognized by a solid line running parallel to the curb. An additional 5’ foot bike lane will be added toward the center of the street with another line for identification.

This is a temporary resurfacing measure planned for early summer, 2010, that will involve grinding in some areas for leveling and adding a new layer of pavement. Dates and time of day have not yet been determined. They are looking at both daytime and possible night time work to complete the project quickly. There will be some storm drain work done on the west end of Front Street, but should have marginal effect on traffic flow.
