

Working Washington Grant Application Information

On Tuesday, Gov. Inslee announced \$5 million in grants to businesses with up to 10 full-time employees that have been forced to close their doors due to the COVID-19 crisis.

We expect Clallam County businesses will be awarded approximately \$85,000 to \$90,000 in grants.

Every application will be evaluated carefully, but not every business that applies will receive funds. There is not nearly enough funding to bridge the needs of all local businesses through this crisis period.

We are pressing our legislators and the governor to get back into session and fund more programs to help you.
